



## Gift Card Holder



1. Cut Cherry Cobbler card 4-1/8" x 11". Score along the 11" length at 2", 7-1/4" and 7-3/8". Fold all score lines.
2. Attach Whisper card 3-7/8" x 3-3/8" to the 3-1/2" end of the Real Red card with the double score lines using temporary adhesive. Make sure that there is an equal amount of Real Red card showing on either side of the Whisper White card and that the top edges are matching. Slide the card into the Envelope Punch Board so that the edge of the Real Red card lines up at the 1" mark and punch. Flip the card over and line up the edge of the Real Red card with the 1" mark and punch. Separate the two pieces.
3. Emboss the Whisper White card using the Holly Embossing Folder and making sure that the image is the right way up. The punched end is the bottom of the panel.
4. Attach the embossed panel to the Real Red card
5. Attach Designer Series Paper 3-7/8" x 1-3/4" to the 2" panel of Real Red card.
6. Make sure that the 2" flap with the Designer Series Paper is folded up. Wrap the Designer Series paper with Real Red Striped Satin Ribbon and tie a knot.
7. Cut Whisper White card 6-1/2" x 3-5/8". Score along the 6-1/2" length at 1-3/4" and 6". Fold along the score lines.
8. Emboss the 1-3/4" section of the Whisper White card, using the Holly Embossing Folder and making sure that the embossing will be facing the correct way.
9. Fold up the embossed section and slide into the pocket behind the Designer Series Paper. Apply Fast Fuse to the 1/2" section of the Whisper White card.
10. Close the top flap over the Whisper White card to adhere to the top panel.
11. Stamp "Merry" onto Whisper White card 2-1/8" x 2-3/4" using Real Red ink.
12. Stamp the Gingerbreadman onto scrap Whisper White card using Crumb Cake ink and punch out using the Cookie Cutter Punch.
13. Punch two circles from Real Red card and attach to the Gingerbreadman to represent buttons.
14. Colour the Gingerbreadman's eyes using a Soft Sky marker.



15. Attach the Gingerbreadman underneath the "Merry".
16. Attach the Whisper White card to Real Red card 2-1/4" x 2-7/8".
17. Attach the Gingerbreadman panel to the Gift Card Holder using dimensionals.
18. Stamp the "Christmas" banner onto scrap Whisper White card using Real Red ink and cut out.
19. Attach "Christmas" across the Gingerbreadman using dimensionals.

I hope you have enjoyed making your Gift Card Holder today and that you find the instructions useful in the future.
