

Framed Art



Panel 1



- 1. Use the stars and moon thinlit die from the Card Front Builders Dies to cut across the top of Whisper White card 2-3/4" x 3-3/4".
- 2. Attach Dazzling Details Glimmer paper 2-3/4" x 4cm behind the cut outs.
 - 3. Attach the panel to Basic Black card 3" x 4".
- 4. Cut the double tree and the single tree from Always Artichoke card using the Card Front Builder Dies.
 - 5. Attach the double tree flat to the Whisper White panel.
 - 6. Attach the single tree using mini dimensionals.
- 7. Cut the reindeer from Soft Suede card, again using the Card Front Builders Dies.
- 8. Attach the Reindeer to the panel, slightly over the double trees.

Panel 2



- 1. Emboss Whisper White card 3-3/4" x 2-3/4" using the Pinewood Planks Embossing Folder.
- 2. Cut the Noel from Cherry Cobbler card using the Christmas Stockings Framelits Dies.
- 3. Attach across the top of the embossed Whisper White card, trimming the ends as necessary.
- 4. Stamp three stocking images from the Hang Your Stocking stamp set using Cherry Cobbler ink.
 - 5. Cut out the stockings using the matching Christmas Stocking

Framelit die.

- 6. Cut out three stocking "hangers" from Cherry Cobbler card also using the Christmas Stockings Framelits Dies.
- 7. Attach the hangers to the corner of the stockings using tombow Multipurpose Glue or Fine Tip glue.
- 8. Attach the stockings to the embossed Whisper White card so that they are hanging from the "Noel".
- 9. Attach the panel to Basic Black card 4" x 3".

Panel 3



- 1. Emboss Whisper White card 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" using the Cable Knit Embossing Folder.
 - 2. Attach the embossed card to 3" x 3" Basic Black card.
- 3. Stamp the Reindeer image from the Cookie Cutter Christmas stamp set onto Whisper White card using Soft Suede ink.
 - 4. Cut the image out using a Layering Circle Framelit Die.
- 5. Attach the image to a Cherry Cobbler scalloped Circle Framelit Die.
- 6. Attach the Reindeer to the centre of the embossed Whisper White card.
 - 7. Punch a ½" circle from Cherry Cobbler card.
- 8. Cut the circle in half and attach half over the nose of the reindeer.

Panel 4



7. Attach the bow to the wreath.

- 1. Stamp the first flower image from the Painted Harvest stamp set onto Whisper White card 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" using Old Olive ink.
- 2. Stamp the second flower over the top of the first image using Always Artichoke ink.
- 3. Attach the stamped Whisper White card to Basic Black card 3" x 3".
- 4. Punch three circles from Gold Glimmer paper using the Holly Berry Builder Punch and attach to the stamped image.
- 5. Punch a bow from Cherry Cobbler card using the Holly Berry Builder Punch.
- 6. Cut a narrow piece of Gold Glimmer card and attach to the centre of the bow.

Panel 5



- 1. Emboss Whisper White card 3-3/4" x 2-3/4" using the Softly Falling Embossing Folder.
 - 2. Attach the embossed card to Basic Black card 4" x 3".
- 3. Stamp the candle image from the Merry Patterns stamp set onto Whisper White card using Memento Tuxedo Black ink.
- 4. Stamp the two fill images for the candles using Cherry Cobbler ink.
- 5. Stamp the fill image for the candle flames using Crushed Curry ink.
 - 6. Cut the image using a Layering Oval Framelit Die.
- 7. Attach to a Cherry Cobbler scalloped Layering Oval Framelit val.
- 8. Attach the image panel to the embossed Whisper White card.

Panel 6



- 1. Stamp the swirly image from the Star of Light stamp set onto Whisper White card 2-3/4" x 3-3/4" using Smoky Slate ink.
- 2. Stamp the greeting from the stamp stamp set over the lower left hand corner using Cherry Cobbler ink.
 - 3. Cut the star image from Gold Glimmer Paper.
 - 4. Attach the star to the top right hand corner of the stamped card.
 - 5. Attach to Basic Black card 3" x 4".

Panel 7



1. Attach Designer Series paper ½" x 3-3/4" to Basic Black card ¾" x 4".

Assembling the panels

- 1. My frame is an A4 document frame. I took the frame apart and placed my Crumb Cake card into the frame and added the glass and the stand to the back.
- 2. Using the photo as a guide attach the panels to A4 Crumb Cake card.
