



## Framed Art



You will need an A4 document frame for this project. Alternatively, you can use the panels to create 7 Christmas cards if you so wish.

### Panel 1



1. Stamp the medium filigree star from the So Many Stars stamp set onto Whisper White card 5cm x 9.5cm using Night of Navy ink.
2. Stamp "Peace" from the So Many Stars stamp set onto the lower right hand corner using Night of Navy ink.
3. Emboss the panel using the Subtle 3D Embossing Folder.
4. Cut one large star and one small star from Night of Navy card using the Stitched Stars Dies.
5. Cut one large filigree and one small star from Silver Foil card using the Stitched Stars Dies..
6. Attach the large filigree star to the large Night of Navy star.
7. Attach to the embossed Whisper White panel.
8. Attach the small filigree star to the small Night of Navy star.
9. Attach to the embossed Whisper White panel.
10. Attach the Whisper White card to Night of Navy card 5.5cm x 10cm.

## Panel 2



1. Stamp the greeting from the Christmas Gleaming stamp set onto the lower right hand corner of Whisper White card 9cm x 9.5cm.
2. Emboss the stamped card using the Subtle 3D Embossing Folder.
3. Stamp the large bauble from the Christmas Gleaming stamp set onto Night of Navy card using Delicata Silvery Shimmer ink three times.
4. Punch out the large baubles using the co-ordinating Gleaming Ornaments Punch.
5. Stamp the small bauble from the Christmas Gleaming stamp set onto Night of Navy card using Delicata Silvery Shimmer ink three times.
6. Punch out the small baubles using the co-ordinating Gleaming Ornaments Punch.

7. Score each of the baubles down the centre and fold on the score line.
8. Attach one bauble to the next using glue on one half only.
9. Attach the third bauble to the outside of the baubles using glue on one half only.
10. Attach Braided Linen Thread behind the back of each bauble – use a Glue Dot to hold it in place.
11. Attach the baubles to the Embossed Whisper White card, wrap the end of the Braided Linen Thread to the back of the Embossed Whisper White card. See example for finished result.
12. Attach the embossed card to Night of Navy card 9.5cm x 10cm.
13. Tie a bow in a length of Braided Linen Thread and attach to the top of each bauble using Mini Glue Dots.

## Panel 3



1. Stamp the filigree multiple star image from the So Many Stars stamp set onto Whisper White card 4.5cm x 9.5cm using Night of Navy ink.
2. Stamp "Love" from the So Many Stars stamp set onto the lower right hand corner using Night of Navy ink.
3. Emboss the stamped Whisper White card using the Subtle 3D Embossing Folder.
4. Cut the filigree star image from Silver Foil using the Stitched Stars Dies.
5. Trim away the excess die.
6. Attach the outline for the stars around the stamped stars.
7. Attach the Whisper White panel to Night of Navy card 5cm x 10cm.

## Panel 4



1. Stamp "Sweet Christmas wishes" from the Cup of Christmas stamp set onto the top left hand corner of Whisper White card 6cm x 9.5cm using Night of Navy ink.
2. Emboss the stamped Whisper White card using the Subtle 3D Embossing Folder.
3. Cut the mug image using the Cup of Christmas dies from Night of Navy card.
4. Cut one solid "candy cane" using the Cup of Christmas dies from Night of Navy card.
5. Cut the striped filigree cup image using the Cup of Christmas dies from Silver Foil card.
6. Cut the filigree "candy cane" using the Cup of Christmas dies from Silver Foil card.
7. Attach the striped filigree image to the Night of Navy mug.
8. Attach the filigree "candy cane" to the solid "candy cane."
9. Attach the candy cane to the embossed Whisper White card.
10. Attach the mug over the candy cane using dimensionals.
11. Attach the embossed Whisper White card to Night of Navy card 6.5cm x 9.5cm.

## Panel 5



1. Ink up a Sponge Brayer using Night of Navy ink and brayer onto Whisper White card 13cm x 8.5cm. Continue to add colour using the brayer until you are happy with the result.
2. Stamp the star image from the Elfie stamp set over the top ¾" of the panel using Delicata Silvery Shimmer ink.
3. Cut Whisper White card using the sleigh die from the Jolly Season Dies.
4. Cut "tis the season" from Whisper White card using the Jolly Seasons Die.
5. Attach the sleigh and the greeting to the brayered panel.
6. Attach the brayered panel to Night of Navy card 13.5cm x 9cm.

## Panel 6



1. Stamp "celebrate the season" from the Sip Sip Hooray stamp set onto the bottom of Whisper White card 6cm x 8.5cm using Night of Navy ink.
2. Stamp the glass image from the Sip Sip Hooray stamp set onto the Whisper White card using Night of Navy ink.
3. Stamp the fill image from the Sip Sip Hooray stamp set inside the glass using Night of Navy ink which has been stamped onto scrap paper first.
4. Stamp the "straw" image from the Sip Sip Hooray stamp set into the glass using Night of Navy ink.
5. Emboss the stamped Whisper White card using the Subtle 3D embossing Folder.
6. Attach the stamped card to Night of Navy card 6.5cm x 9cm.



## Panel 7



1. Stamp the greeting from the So Many Stars stamp set onto the lower right hand corner of Whisper White card 6.5cm x 8.5cm using Night of Navy ink.
2. Emboss the stamped Whisper White card using the Subtle 3D Embossing Folder.
3. Cut the filigree die from the Stitched Stars Dies from Night of Navy card.
4. Cut one solid star using the Stitched Stars Dies from Night of Navy card.
5. Cut one solid star using the Stitched Stars Dies from Mercury Glass Designer Acetate.
6. Attach the Mercury Glass Designer Acetate star to the Night of Navy star.
7. Attach the filigree panel to the back of the star.
8. Attach the whole piece to the stamped and embossed Whisper White card.
9. Attach the Whisper White panel to Night of Navy card 7cm x 9cm.

## Assembling The Framed Art

1. Use an A4 document frame and remove the glass and papers.
2. Place the papers on top of the glass.
3. Place an A4 sheet of Sahara Sand card on top of the papers.
4. Place the papers and glass back into the frame with the Sahara Sand card on top.
5. Arrange your panels onto the Sahara Sand card using the photo/example as a guide.
6. You can arrange your panels in a different order. **PLEASE NOTE** that the lengths of the panels in the top and bottom rows are different.
