



## Pop Up Cube Card



### Large Cube

Cut card 5-1/2" x the length of an A4 Sheet (or 11-1/2").

Score along the long edge at 2-3/4", 5-1/2", 8-1/4" and 11".

### Template for outside of cube



Cut two layers 2-1/2" x 5-1/4"

Cut two Whisper White panels 2-1/4" x 5".

Emboss one of the Whisper White panels  
Cut two layers 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"  
Cut two Whisper White panels 2-1/4" x 2-1/4", emboss as required.

### Template for inside of cube



Cut two Whisper White panels 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" and emboss using your desired embossing folder

### Small Cubes

Cut card 2-3/4" x length of an A4 sheet (or 11-1/2")  
Score along the long edge at 2-3/4", 5-1/2", 8-1/4" and 11"

### Template for Front Left Hand Cube



Cut two layers 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"  
Cut Whisper White card 2-1/4" x 2-1/4", emboss as necessary.

### Template for Inside Left Hand Cube



Cut tab 2-1/2" x 3/4", score at 1-1/4". Add adhesive on both sides of the fold.

Remove adhesive from one half and attach to the inside panel lining up the fold with the outside of the card.

Cut two layers 2-1/2" x 2-1/2".

### Template for Front Right Hand Cube



Create panels and attach as per Left Hand Panel.

### Template for Inside Right Hand Cube



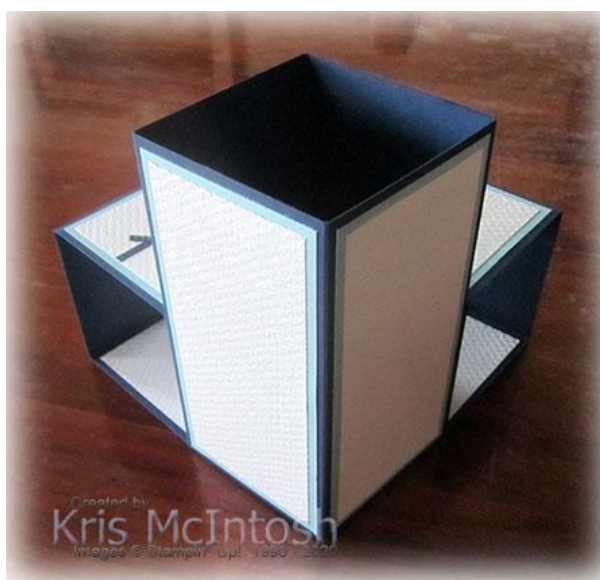
Create tab and attach so that it is in line with the tab on the left inside panel.

Cut panels and attach as per Left Hand Panel.



Fold all the score lines and add tear and tape or Stampin' Seal + across the small tab on each panel and create three cubes. Attach the small cubes where indicated on the Large Cube outside template.

You add adhesive on the small panels on the back of the panel with the tab. Fold the large cube flat and align the bottom of the small cube with the bottom of the large cube, making sure to adhere the right hand panel to the right hand side and the left hand panel to the left hand side. You also need to make sure that you stay just inside the centre score line on the large cube.



I hope you find these instructions useful. I recommend that you create the templates and that you create one card base using scrap card so that you have a visual reference.
