

Gift Card Holder



This gift card holder was shared way back in August 2018 on a Demonstrator Only Facebook Page by Deseree Buss Krumm. I have altered the dimensions somewhat to fit our A4 card.

Product Used:

Words of Cheer stamp set
Christmas Cheer Dies
Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder
Tailored Tag Punch

Memento Tuxedo Black, Shaded Spruce ink Peaceful Prints Designer Series Paper Cherry Cobbler, Shaded Spruce Stampin' Blends.

Base Card:

10.5cm x 14.8cm. You could use a standard opening card base if you wish.

Folding Panel:

25.5cm x 12.8cm, scored along the 25.5cm length at 8.5cm and 17cm.

Designer Series Paper Layers

8cm x 12.3cm

- 1. Cut Folding Panel from Basic White card 25.5cm x 12.8cm, scored along the 25.5cm length at 8.5cm and 17cm.
- 2. Fold the panel on the score lines using your bone folder.
- 3. Emboss Cherry Cobbler card 8cm x 12.3cm using the Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder.


4. Attach the embossed card to the front panel of the folded Basic White card.



- 5. Stamp the image from the Words of Cheer stamp set onto Basic White card using Memento Tuxedo Black ink.
- 6. Colour the image using Cherry Cobbler and Shaded Spruce Stampin' Blends.
 - 7. Cut out the image using the co-ordinating Christmas Cheer Die.
- 8. Attach the die cut image to the embossed Cherry Cobbler card using dimensionals.
 - 9. Stamp the greeting from the Words
- of Cheer stamp set onto Basic White card using Shaded Spruce ink.
- 10. Attach the greeting across the centre of the stamped and coloured image.
- 11. Punch the bottom of Designer Series Paper 8cm x 12.3cm using the



Tailored Tag punch. Push the punch all the way into the Designer Series Paper and centre it along the short end.



- 13. Attach the punched Designer Series Paper panel to the centre panel of the Basic White folded panel.
- 14. Emboss Cherry Cobbler card 8cm x 12.3cm using the Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder.
 - 15. Attach the embossed Cherry Cobbler card to the last panel of

the folded Basic White card.

- 16. Cut Basic White card using the Stitched Rectangle Die.
- 17. Attach the Basic White die cut panel to the centre of the embossed Cherry Cobbler card.
- 18. Cut Base Card from Shaded Spruce card 10.5cm x 14.8cm.
- 19. Add adhesive to the back of the folded panel and attach to the centre of the Shaded Spruce card.



Here is the variation using the Love Santa Card Kit.

Product Used:

Love Santa Tag Kit Basic White, Just Jade and Poppy Parade A4 Card

Base Card:

10.5cm x 14.8cm. You could use a standard opening card base if you wish.

Folding Panel:

25.5cm x 12.8cm, scored along the 25.5cm length at 8.5cm and 17cm.

Designer Series Paper Layers

8cm x 12.3cm





- 1. Cut Folding Panel from Basic White card 25.5cm x 12.8cm, scored along the 25.5cm length at 8.5cm and 17cm.
 - 2. Fold the panel on the score lines using your bone folder.
- 3. Emboss Poppy Parade/Just Jade card 8cm x 12.3cm using the Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder.
- 4. Attach the embossed card to the front panel of the folded Basic White card.
- 5. Create the Love Santa Tag following the instructions included in the Kit.
- 6. Attach the tag to the front panel on the folding card base using dimensionals.
- 7. Punch the bottom of Designer Series Paper 8cm x 12.3cm using the Tailored Tag punch. Push the punch all the way into the Designer Series Paper and centre it along the short end.
 - 8. Add adhesive to the back of the panel, making sure that you only add adhesive on the very outside
 - edge of the bottom of the panel and leave the bottom section of the punched opening clear of adhesive.
 - 9. Emboss Poppy Parade/Just Jade card 8cm x 12.3cm using the Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder.
 - 10. Attach the embossed card to the last panel of the folded Basic White

card.

- 11. Cut Basic White card using the Stitched Rectangle Die.
- 12. Attach the Basic White die cut panel to the centre of the embossed card.
- 13. Cut Base Card from Poppy Parade/Just Jade card 10.5cm x 14.8cm.
- 14. Add adhesive to the back of the folded panel and attach to the centre of the Poppy Parade/Just Jade card.



I hope that you find the instructions useful for creating this gift card holder, now and in the future.
